Every child has equal value in the eyes of God and therefore, within the school, this equality must work and be seen to work in practice. None should be disadvantaged on any grounds whatsoever, whether on grounds of gender, nationality, religion, wealth or natural gifts. School arrangements reflect this in every aspect of its life.

The academic aims of the school are expressed in the school's Curriculum Policy, a copy of which follows, and which is also contained in the Curricula Document File.

The school has been designated "Christian" by Statutory Instrument dated 17th May 2004.
