Literacy (L)

- Begin to trace/copy/write own name.
- Some begin their word sets.
- Learning to recognise our names and the initial letter sound.
- Revise the alphabet sounds.
- Talk about the marks they make with an adult.
- Talk about pictures and characters from our stories.
- Recognising letters/words around the setting.
- Begin to form letters independently.
- Re-telling a story hungry caterpillar using props.
- Create a class flap book of minibeasts.
- Look at non-fiction books.
- Make 'who am I books' label pictures of bugs

Mathematics (M)

- Sorting different coloured objects into sets.
- Act out different numbers e.g. 4 claps, 8 jumps.
- Recognise 1-5/1-10.
- Sequence 1-5/1-10.
- Sort by size, colour, number and type.
- Organise by short and tall.
- Use and understand language over/under, big/small.
- Montessori large stair and bead stair.
- Minibeast games ladybird counting, butterfly symmetry.

Personal Social Emotional Development (PSED)

- · Learning to work as part of a group.
- Trying out new activities independently and select resources with some help.
- Form relationships with adults and peers in nursery and lower school.
- Respond to ideas of others, co-operatively playing etc
- Coping positively with change, preparing for transition out of nursery (starting school).
- Talk about how to care for/look after and be gentle with minibeasts.
- Make posters about how to look after minibeasts.

Physical Development (PD)

- Explore different ways of travelling (PE lessons).

Communication and Language (CL)
